## Family Picnic:

Megan Nichols gave an update on the plans for family picnic to be held on September 12 ${ }^{\text {th }} 5: 30-7: 30$. Kona Ice and Domino's pizza are confirmed as food options for the event. We also discussed moving the event to be closer to the playground to showcase the playground that was updated over the summer with PTO donation funds. It was also discussed to have a vision board with ideas of new playground structures the board and staff would like to add to the area in the coming year.

## Invest Update:

Kristi Cobb spoke on the Invest in Longview reports as of the current date. Currently $51.8 \%$ of the school has invested. She plans on having the car sign up available mid-September and donations for candy information by the $1^{\text {st }}$ of October.
